Cultural Heritage Services

As the nominated Aboriginal Heritage Service Provider (AHSP) for the Gnaala Karla Booja Indigenous Land Use Agreement (ILUA) region, GKB Impact delivers comprehensive heritage services including:

- Heritage surveys
- On-site cultural heritage monitors
- Anthropological and archaeological support services
- Regulatory and statutory compliance

GKB Impact is equipped with Ground Penetrating Radar technology to assist in archaeological investigations and subsurface assessments. Our team of anthropologists, archaeologists, and heritage specialists manage all aspects of Aboriginal heritage across the ILUA region.



Land Management Services

GKB Impact operates three Aboriginal ranger teams undertaking a wide range of land management activities to care for and restore Country. Current services include:

- Vegetation removal
- Fauna monitoring, assessment, and conservation
- Cultural burning, firebreak management, and fuel reduction
- Revegetation and restoration planting
- Native seed collection
- Marine and coastal debris removal
- Fencing installation
- Invasive weed control
- Feral animal control

We are also building capacity to expand our service delivery into the following areas:

- Offset lot management
- Forest management
- Ecological thinning
- Environmental/ecological surveys and monitoring
